



## **FAMILY HISTORY CLASS AT TOLLESON PUBLIC LIBRARY WEB TOUR INCLUDES ANCESTRY LIBRARY EDITION**

The Tolleson Public library is offering a one-hour free class on August 19, 2016, from 11:00 AM to 12:00 PM that includes a tour of a premium web site, Ancestry Library, accessible free from the library. The class will show you how to uncover family history as you data-mine the library's digital family archives.

"This class will cover the types of content you will find, such as images from the U.S. Census from 1790, and the functionality of the site that will help you complete your family's narrative story," instructor Paula Wilson, Library Consultant, said.

These premium web sites are available in the library for free or from any computer with your library card number. The class is intended for teens and adults. Students may register at the library by calling 623-936-2746. Students may bring their own laptop or follow along with the instructor.

The web sites highlighted are a part of the [Digital Arizona Library](#) (DAZL), available to all residents of Arizona through their public library website.
