

RESOLUTION NO. 2312

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOLLESON, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2016.

WHEREAS, a general municipal election was held on November 8, 2016 (the “Election”) for the election of a council member in the City of Tolleson, Maricopa County, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the Election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the City Council;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Tolleson, Maricopa County, Arizona as follows:

Section 1. The total number of ballots for the council member seat cast at the Election, as shown by the poll list was 1561.

Section 2. The total number of ballots rejected was 12.

Section 3. The votes cast for the candidates for the council member seat were as follows:

John A. Carnero	1032 votes
Donnie Gerhart	525 votes
Write-in Candidate	4 votes

Section 4. It is hereby found, determined and declared of record, the following candidate did receive a majority of the total number of valid votes cast and is hereby issued a Certificate of Election:

John A. Carnero

Section 5. This Resolution shall constitute the official canvass and be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.

Section 6. The Mayor, the City Manager, the City Clerk, and the City Attorney are hereby authorized and directed to take all steps necessary to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
